TOWN ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Broskey gave the Town Engineer's Report as follows:

- Water Line Project The railroad approved the work by Tiger Market and the contractor is working on scheduling that with railroad personnel.
- Sunrise Village ARC funding was awarded to add 17 connections to the system at Sunrise Village on the four-lane in the amount of approximately \$300,000.

a. Projects Update

Mr. Lawson gave the following updates to Council:

• DHCD – received an extension on the ARC grants for work at Big Cherry, \$1.5 million for water, sewer and electrical; \$875K plus \$150K from Friends of Southwest Virginia and Town match for road work, drainage, bridges on the trails, new trails and overlook work. The extension is until September 2027.

- July 4th events are going well but weather has impacted a couple of the events. Pickleball tournament was successful with 36 pickleball teams. We had 10 basketball teams, hotdog contest was today with the winner eating 7 hotdogs. Tomorrow is Gospel night, Karaoke on Thursday, and Friday's 4th events are the Pancake Breakfast 8AM-11AM and the Freedom 5K Run starting at 9AM by the Gap Corporation. The parade will start at 4 with the Grand Marshall's being the fire fighters that were awarded 20 years of service, had a sign made for them for the parade.
- The new cross on the Downtown Tank was installed in one day.
- 1/3 of the sidewalk on Clinton has been repaired and work is still being done.
- Starting today there will begin a big push on Blue Highway Festival's marketing and advertising campaign.
- Thanks to everyone that came to the Garfield Long Sr. Cemetery dedication. It was a great event.

Councilwoman Bailey said the Garfield Long Sr. Cemetery dedication was a nice service and she was glad to attend. She thanked all the town employees. She said the brunch at the 404 Café and Creamery was wonderful.

Mayor Johnson thanked Councilman Bloomer for the pickleball event. He thanked all the town employees for the work they put it for the 4th of July week.
